

Curriculum Overview

Key Stage 3 (Y7 & 8)

In Year 7 and 8 students access a wide range of subjects across the curriculum. A heavy focus on the core subjects complemented by a variety of other subjects enables students to develop a number of key skills. The KS3 curriculum is supported by a number of 'drop-down' days across the year when PSHCE is delivered to students in both large and small groups.

Key Stage 4 (Y9-11)

Subjects studied in KS4 are split into core (compulsory) and options. The options that students can choose are based on the pathway that they are placed on, which is based on their attainment at KS3.

All students follow the core curriculum, consisting of:

*PSHCE will be delivered via drop down days in Y10 and Y11.

The core subjects are complemented by a number of option subjects that can be chosen by students. These will be delivered over a number of hours per week depending on which

pathway the student is on. They usually take place over two years. The options choices consist of:

Key Stage 5 (Y12 & 13)
