Parents/Carers: I/We shall ensure that:


- My/our child will attend the Academy on those days it is open, punctually, dressed in full uniform and equipped to learn.
- I/we will avoid taking holidays during term time.
- I/we will value the education that my child receives and encourage and support all their learning and achievements.
- I/we will contact the attendance office on the morning of any absence giving a reason and expected date of return.
- I/we will make the Academy aware of any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour.
- I/we support the Academies policies and procedures for behaviour.
- I/we will support the Academy's approach to online safety, cyber-bullying and malicious communications.
- I/we will attend Parents' Evenings for discussion about my child's progress where there is a concern or lack of progress.
- I/we will encourage my child to work hard and support them by checking the planner each week and by providing them with the opportunity to complete work at home.
